



Curt Daniels **MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Purpose

The Curt Daniels Memorial Scholarship was established within the Vancouver School District Foundation to provide a \$1,000 college tuition scholarship to a graduating senior attending a Vancouver School District high school who has demonstrated a passion for the game of baseball.

The scholarship will be awarded to an individual who meets the eligibility requirements listed below, demonstrates financial need, is a positive role model both on and off the baseball field, and is of good standing at school and in the community.

Eligibility

- Be a graduating senior from a Vancouver School District high school
- Show intent and desire to continue education at an accredited two or four-year college or university, vocational school or technical training program
- Maintained a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or above
- Demonstrates financial need
- Played four (4) years in a high school baseball program (varsity level not required)
- Participated in a community based summer baseball program during your high school years
- Display strong character, work ethic and leadership abilities

Directions to Apply

1. Complete the following application and a typed narrative no longer than one (1) page in length that addresses the questions listed under the *Attachment* section of this application.
2. Include one (1) sealed copy of your high school transcript.
3. Submit a letter from EACH of the following individuals describing you and your qualities as they pertain to the purpose and requirements of this scholarship award.
 - A baseball coach for whom you have recently played.
 - A teacher, employer or other adult that knows you well, but is not related to you.
4. The application and attached materials must be typewritten. Incomplete or handwritten applications will not be reviewed.
5. Application packets must be received in the Foundation office on or before the deadline stated below to be considered. Applications received after that date will not be accepted. You may mail or hand-deliver your packet.

 - Include anything else you would like the review committee to know about you personally.

CERTIFICATION

I acknowledge that this is a competitive selection process and that the decision of the Scholarship Committee and the Vancouver School District Foundation is final.

I certify that the information provided is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge and that intentional misrepresentation is cause for disqualification. If asked, I agree to provide proof of the information I have provided. The scholarship committee has my permission to contact my references and/or school officials for additional academic or character reference information.

If selected to receive a scholarship, I understand that the scholarship must be used during the school year that immediately follows the year of my high school graduation.

I further understand that if selected as the award recipient, the scholarship amount will be paid to the post secondary school I have identified and that I am not eligible to be reimbursed for any previous tuition expenses. As such, the scholarship award will not be paid directly to me under any circumstances.

SELECTION PROCESS

Applications and attached materials will be reviewed by the scholarship committee.

The scholarship committee may choose to interview some or all applicants.

Recommendation from the committee shall be sufficient evidence of compliance with the donor's wishes so as to permit the VSD Foundation to make the award and distribute funds to the designated institution towards cost of tuition.

Notification letters will be mailed to all applicants by May 3, 2010.
